## *BACK TO SCHOOL FAQ*

### **What are the office hours?**

The office is open from 8:15-4:15. When visitors come into the building, they need to check-in to get a visitor's pass before walking in the building.

### **Is there security at the school?**

There is a secure door that needs opened by office staff while students are at school. This procedure is for any visitors during school hours.

### **What are the school day hours?**

School begins at 8:50 every day and ends at 3:50 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Students are released at 2:50 on Wednesdays to provide collaboration time for the teachers.

### **When can students enter the building?**

Students are welcomed at 8:20 into the cafeteria, where they can eat breakfast or wait to go to the playground. The playground is supervised from 8:35-8:50. There is a primary playground for K-2 students and an intermediate playground for 3-5 grade students.

### **Does breakfast cost money for students?**

Breakfast is free for all students. We encourage our students to have a healthy breakfast to be ready for a day of learning.

**What resources are provided for Reed families?**

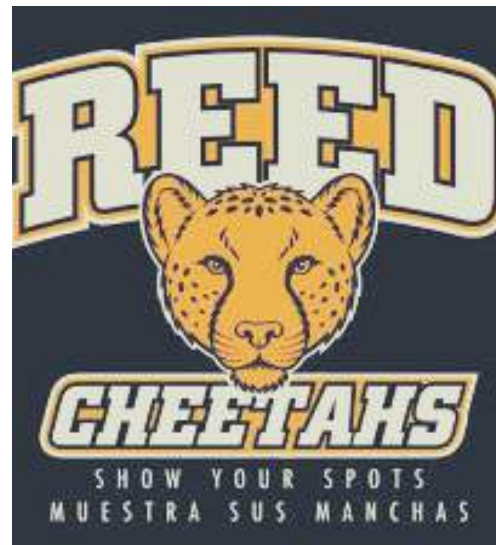
